Dear Nursing Regulator,

Nurse practitioner (NP) scopes of practice vary in individual provinces and territories. Therefore, to better understand the similarities and differences, the Nurse Practitioner Association of Canada (NPAC) and the Canadian Institute for Health Information (CIHI) are working together to collect data on scopes of practice for NPs across all Canadian Provinces and Territories.

The data collection sheet presents a comprehensive list of scopes of practice for NPs. We would like to understand for each one of them if it exists as full, reduced or restricted NP practice in your province or territory or if it is not in scope of practice for NPs as of December 2019.

Babita Gupta, Program Lead, Health Workforce Information at CIHI and NPAC have agreed that NPAC will collect the data from the nursing regulators.

The data template is attached, and we'd appreciate it if you can complete it by February 5, 2020 or shortly after if possible.
