Abstract Submission Guidelines

Step 1: Presentation Type

Determine what type of presentation abstract you will submit.

- Oral (20-minute presentation, 5 minute Q&A)
- Poster (6 minute presentation, 2 minute Q&A)
- Workshop (90 minutes interactive session)

Step 2: Category of Submission

Determine what category your abstract fits within.

- Clinical Practice – specify practice area
- Leadership/Advocacy
- Research/Quality Improvement
- Education

Step 3: Submission Details

Complete all the submission details.

- Title (limit 100 characters with spaces)
- Objectives (limit 300 characters with spaces)
- Background (limit 750 characters with spaces)
- Methods (limit 750 characters with spaces)



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- Discussion (limit 750 characters with spaces)
- Relevance to NP Practice (limit 750 characters with spaces)
- Key learnings (limits 750 characters with spaces)
- References (Citations in APA 7th ed, and within 5 years unless seminal work)

Step 4: Authors

No more than 2 presenters for oral podium or 4 presenters for workshop.

- First Name
- Last Name
- Credentials
- Email address (please ensure this is correct)
- Secondary email address
- City
- Country
- Institution you are representing/work for
- Professional designation

Step 5: Permission to Publish

Indicate Yes or No.

Step 6: Author Approval

Confirm that this submission has been approved by all authors listed in the abstract.



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Step 7: Author Attendance

Confirm that at least one author will register in full to attend and present at the conference.
